**O**ur vision is of a world in which families are safe and secure, all people have enough to eat and a roof overhead, children go to good schools, health care is available when needed, people with disabilities are able to do everything they are able to do and people of all languages and cultures feel at home with each other.

**Every day we work to ensure that our vision is one day realized...**

In 2011, Georgia Legal Services staff and volunteers closed almost 8,500 cases; handled 2,853 calls to its Landlord/Tenant Helpline; presented legal education sessions to 25,936 residents in hundreds of community settings; and referred 17,840 individuals to private attorneys on a pro bono or reduced fee basis.

**Some recent highlights of our work include:**

- A 2010 ruling in a GLSP case changed a state policy and helped hundreds of nursing home residents stay in their homes, rather than being evicted for non-payment of medical bills accrued before they were certified for Medicaid.
- Many children have been able to continue their education after dismissal of unfounded disciplinary proceedings, and/or provided appropriate educational services to accommodate their disabilities, because of representation by GLSP attorneys.
- Schools have been persuaded to follow federal law and admit parentless children without requiring formal adult guardianship proceedings, and systems have been required to admit and even transport homeless children to their former school, as a result of GLSP advocacy.
- Legal Services Corporation recognized GLSP's leadership in the fight to ensure access to justice when it selected GLSP Executive Director Phyllis Holmen as one of six legal services directors to participate in a White House forum to examine the state of legal aid nationwide.
