Volunteer Remotely with a Signature Project

Signature Projects are statewide projects, overseen by a subject-matter expert attorney, that host quarterly clinics to provide opportunities for volunteers to remotely serve clients across Georgia.

Credit and Identity Project

Assists clients in reviewing their credit profiles, evaluates legal issues related to credit/debt, and provides counsel and advice.

Disaster Legal Services Project

Places cases in the wake of state or federally declared disaster events. Between events, maintains resources, partnerships and systems necessary to support rapid response.

Record Restriction Project

Coordinates restriction of criminal records for clients, removing obstacles to obtaining employment, housing, and other supports.

Wills and Estates Project

Generates wills, advanced directives for healthcare, and powers of attorney to protect generational wealth and honor clients' wishes.
